As we continue to navigate the effects of COVID-19 in our community, Key City Gymnastics Club stays committed to following directives as set out by Dr. Bonnie Henry, PHO, Interior Health, viaSport, and Gymnastics B.C.

We encourage parents and members to review our Communicable Disease Plan, dated July 6, 2021, our Covid-19 Safety Plan, dated August 24, 2021, and our September 21, 2021, Parent Letter, all of which are available on our Key City Gymnastics Club website.

Key City Gymnastics Club will be maintaining and/or implementing the safety following measures in our facility:

- No spectators will be permitted in Key City Gymnastics Club
- The maximum occupancy for each separate area of Key City Gymnastics Club is 50

BC Mask Mandate Order

Masks have now been mandated for all those ages 9+ years of age and are strongly recommended for children 8 years of age and under. Individuals are required to wear masks when entering and exiting Key City Gymnastics Club and in all common areas.

Exceptions apply:

- to athletes participating in gymnastics in the field of play
- to a person who is less than 9 years of age
- to a person who is unable to wear a face covering because of a psychological, behavioral or health condition, or a physical, cognitive, or mental impairment
- to a person who is unable to put on or remove a face covering without the assistance of another person
- if the face covering is removed temporarily for the purposes of identifying the person wearing it
- while consuming food or beverage at a location designated for those purposes by the operator of the indoor public space
- while communicating with a person who has a hearing impairment.

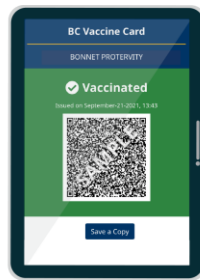
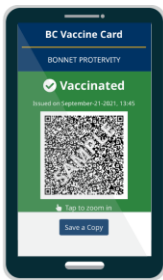
This mandate includes coaches, athletes and any other individuals who occupy the space.

Interior Health Vaccine Update

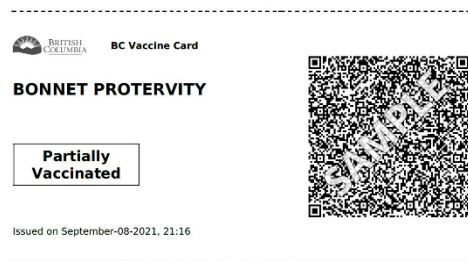
- Vaccine Cards are required by adult participants (22+) to participate in sport activities. Two doses of vaccine are required.
- Vaccine Cards are required by spectators (22+) to observe sport activities in groups of over 50 individuals aged 12+. Two doses of vaccine are required.
